- IPv4 Runout:
est. Aug 2011 – Apr 2012
(in 14-22 months)
- Increased consumption in Asia Pacific region

- Increase in adoption rate
- Receiving regular updates on vendor support
- Adoption rate not fast enough to eliminate last-minute adoption

- Outreach efforts:
 - meetings: RIRs, ICANN, ITU events (IPv6 Group, UN CSTD, ITU WTDC)
 - law enforcement community
- Upcoming:
 - signing in-addr root
 - RPKI service (2011)
- Reach out, Educate and Defend

- Appointed Kuo-Wei Wu to the ICANN BoD (April 2010)
- Monitoring 3 global policy proposals
 - 1 proposal on ASN allocation practice
 - 2 proposals on return & redistribution of IPv4 addresses
- Working to increase ICANN community communication
